The position is to support the national training program with administrative, communications, and data-related support. We are seeking a candidate with strong communication skills as it involves interaction with clinicians throughout the VA system as well as strong organization and attention to detail skills given the complexity and size of the program. There are opportunities for data analysis experience as well as publications and posters with our program evaluation data. This is an opportunity to work on a unique large-scale psychotherapy dissemination initiative.
