Note: International Students are charged the following fees: International Student Fee (ISF) \$250.00, Major Medical Coverage Plan \$967.00, and a \$220.00-\$350.00 SEVIS Administration Fee for J-1 and F-1/M-1 visa holders, respectively, per semester.

All students receive full financial support (a Fellowship, Teaching Assistantship, or Graduate Assistantship) that covers all tuition and provides an annual stipend. At the present time, Fellows receive a stipend of \$25,000 and TA/GAs receive a salary of \$28,569. All students are guaranteed support for five years provided they are in good standing in the program. Students are also eligible for summer support through TA and GA positions. These summer appointments usually carry a stipend of \$1,700-\$3,300, depending on responsibilities. Students are strongly encouraged to apply for residency in New Jersey (see <a href="http://nbregistrar.rutgers.edu/forms/ResidencyAppl.pdf">http://nbregistrar.rutgers.edu/forms/ResidencyAppl.pdf</a>) as soon as they are eligible to reduce tuition costs and enable the department to support more students. Students in their 6th year and beyond are given low priority for departmental funding.
