## Our Program:

The Rutgers Clinical Psychology Ph.D. Program is an APA- and PCSAS- accredited clinical science program devoted to training clinical scientists who conduct and disseminate clinical research. Our program uses a mentorship training model, where students receive individualized mentorship and have access to various clinical and research opportunities within and affiliated with the University. Diversity, equity, and inclusion are core values of the Rutgers program, reflected in faculty and student research, training, and mentorship.

## Equity and Inclusion

Prospective applicants from minoritized and historically excluded backgrounds are encouraged to attend! The Rutgers Clinical Psychology PhD Program seeks a diverse applicant pool and welcomes applicants from minoritized racial/ethnic groups, women, applicants with disabilities, first-generation college graduates, non-traditional students, and LGBTQIA+ applicants. Our faculty research cover a wide range of topics, including adolescent social and emotional development, depression and suicide risk, anxiety and health outcomes, and methodology (e.g., digital technology, clinical and qualitative interviews) to study emotions, thoughts, and risky behaviors in real time. A large group of faculty in the Interdisciplinary Health Program collaboratively study the intersection of mental and physical health and health risk behaviors. We also collaborate with the School of Public Health, Biomedical and Health Sciences, and Graduate School for Applied and Professional Psychology.
